



WHEREAS the Authors of the trust are desirous of creating a charitable trust and executing the requisits DEED OF TRUST setting forth the terms, conditions and provisions thereof for the proper and efficient administration of the trust.

NOW THIS DEED OF TRUST WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS

1. The Trust shall be styled "DESIYA VIDYA KENDRA TRUST" and its office shall be situated at 89, Santhapet, Gudiyattam or at any other place or places as the trustees may determine from time to time.
2. The trust hereby created is not revocable at the instance of the Authors of the trust at any time and under any circumstances.
3. The object of the trust shall be to provide relief for the Poor, Medical Relief, Education to the Public and other objects of general public utility not involving any activities for profit. The above benefits shall be given to the members of the public regardless of Casts, Creed, Community or religion. The objects inter alia shall include:-
 - a) To establish, maintain, run, develop, improve, extend, grant, denote for and to aid and assist in the establishment, maintenance, running, development, improvement and extension of hospitals, clinics, dispensaries, maternity homes, and similar institutions affording treatment, cure, rest, recuperation and other advantages in the way of alleviating the suffering of humanity.
 - b) To establish, maintain, run, develop, improve, extend, grant, denote for and to aid and assist in the establishment, maintenance, running, development, improvement and extension of educational institutions, technical, industrial and others, including, schools, colleges, Balawadies, polytechnics and reserch associations and institutions, workshps, etc., hostals for the benefits of students and to award Scholarships for the study, research and apprenticeship for all or any of the said purpose,

- g) To collect funds by donations, subscriptions, grants, presents or contributions and other offerings for the purpose of revenue or capital expenditure to carry out the objects of the trust.
- h) To invest the trust funds from time to time in such business or securities and in such manner as they deem fit, to alter or vary the investments from time to time to realise the investments to acquire or ot sell securities, debentures, stock and shares, etc.,
- i) To acquire on lease, purchase or otherwise, to sell mortgages, to lease out or transfer in any other manner, propertiás movable or immovable, to construct building and other improvements for the purpose of the trust and to manage and to deal with properties of the trust.
- j) To borrow or raise funds for the fulfilment of the objects of the trust from Banks or any other person/s (Institution/s) dealig in finance ~~either~~ on the security of the trust properties or otherwise.



- k) To receive, collect or realise or cause collection or realisation of all interest, dividends, bonus or premium to accrue, due on all or any stock, funds, securities shares, debentures or deeds or documents of like nature.

- t) Toopen, operate, maintain accounts of any nature in any Bank or Banks of their choice and to authorise operations of the said accounts by any of the said accounts by any of the trustees or any other persons as the trustees may appoint.
 - u) The trustees are authorised to use the nucleus or corpus fund for the objects of the trust.
 - v) To do all other acts, deeds, matters and things which they deem necessary for carrying out the objects of this trust for its administration.
 - w) The trustees may authorise any trustee/s including the chairman/Managing trustee/s to execute any deed or documents for any purpose sanctioned by i
 - x) The trustees shall also carryout effectively the objects of the trust. No such action/deed which is repugnant to the objects of the trust or which defeats the objects of the trust shall be permitted to be carried out. Thus it shall be competent for the trustees to refuse place or accomodiation or otherwise, user of the trust property, where non-vegetarian food, egg or intoxicants and similar things are likely to be used, consumed, cooked or served.
- 9) i) The power enumerated in paragraph 8 above shall be exercised by the trustees subject to their satisfying the conditions laid down by the Income-tax Act 1961 as amended from time to time so that the Income of the trust will be exempt from Income-tax for each and every assessment year.
- ii) The accounting year of the trust shall be year ending on 31st March every year. The trustees may decide to adopt some other accounting year in future.
- 10) All the trustees shall be trustees for life. In case of any vacancy arises against life trustees occasioned by death, resignation or incapacity or otherwise the remaining trustees shall appoint another person as trustee to fill up the vacancy. If any trustee including the chairman of the Board of trustees acts detrimental to the objects of the trust, he can be removed by the 2/3 of the majority of existing trustees. If the conduct of a particular trustee/s including the Chairman of the Board of trustee is/are not satisfactory in the opinion of the 2/3rd Majority of the trustees he/hhey is/are can be removed from the board of trustees.
- 11) In all cases, until the appointment of a new trustee/s the remaining trustees for the time being shall continue to administer the trust, even where the number of trustees falls below three. In such an event, the remaining trustees

- i) Any two trustees, may in writing, requisition the secretary to convene a meeting of the Board of trustees clearly disclosing the matter to be discussed by the trustees and there upon the Secretary shall convene the meeting of the Board of trustees after giving fifteen day's notice of such meeting to the Trustees. In case the secretary fails to respond to the requisition of those trustees, the said trustees themselves may convene a meeting of the Trustees by giving 15 days notice of the proposed meeting to the trustees and the decisions arrived at such meeting shall be as good, valid and binding as if they are the decisions arrived at the meetings of the Board of trustees duly convened provided that atleast two thirds of the total number of trustees attend such meeting and the decisions are supported by a majority of them.

12. All or any of the powers vested in or exercisable by the trustees as per this Deed of trust shall be capable of being performed or exercised by a majority of trustees present at the meeting of the Board of trustees and any action or decision of such majority shall be subject to the provisions contained in, para 11 (i) supra, be as valid and effective as it would have been if done by all the trustees, if however, in the opinion of the Secretary the calling of the meeting of the trustees is impracticable for any reason the resolution passed by the unanimous consent of the trustees by circulation of papers shall be held valid and effective as if passed by the 2/3rd Manority of the trustees at the duly convened meetings. Such circulated papers may be got retified by the board subsequently at its meeting.




